We are pleased that the 2008 Institute for Culture and Society will be held at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, from Tuesday, 10 June through Saturday, 14 June.

The most affordable and convenient housing option is in **Sandburg Residence Hall, UWM** (located less than a block from the conference venue).

In order to guarantee the rates listed below, the conference organizers, Courtney Maloney and Carol Stabile, will be taking reservations, organizing people into suites, and collecting the money.

\$35.00/night/person: Sandburg Residence Hall includes four high-rise towers with apartment-style suites containing three/four bedrooms and one bathroom. The suites in the East Tower are air-conditioned. In order to get the discounted rate of \$35.00/night/person, we will need to fill the suites, meaning that some conference goers will need to share rooms. We are hoping that you can help the conference organizers with this by indicating your willingness to share rooms and letting us know with whom you'd like to room.

The rooms are spacious (no bunk beds) and include towels and linens. Suites also have full kitchens (including refrigerators), although the kitchens are not equipped.

Sandburg is a smoke-free facility. Check-in time is at noon and check-out time at 11 am.
